The Church In Action

One of the great joys in my life is to work with some of the greatest people. Pictured below is Rustam and his wife Sveta. They live in the Ishvesk Region of Russia. We were introduced to them by another couple from America, Igor and Luba.

Rustam is a delivered drug addict who God called to work with the very people he used to be. He didn't know how to begin and had no instructions from anyone, he just began by faith the work God called him to. Remember if God calls He will also provide.



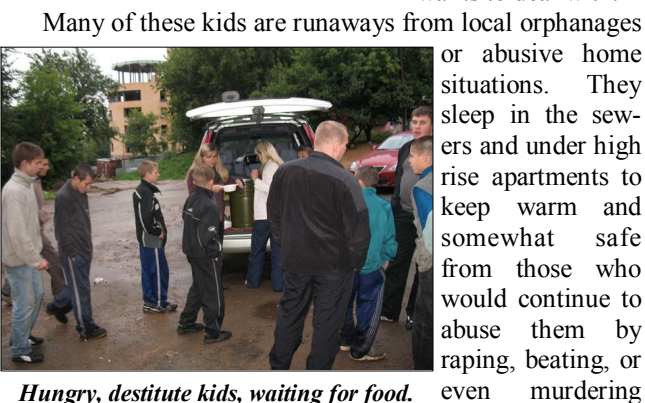
Instead of waiting for people to come to church, he takes the church to them. Now isn't that a novel idea? Just like the church in the book of Acts. Maybe some of our churches should take notes.

He has set up a drug rehab center that takes time to cook several meals a day that are delivered to feeding points within the city to feed the homeless and street kids. They let me follow them for an evenings run. We picked up the food in containers, carried them to feeding points and fed those in need.

One of the places we stopped at had a number of street kids and none of them began eating until Rustam prayed for the food. Hot soup and warm bread and some great conversation and love to these that no one wants to deal with.

Many of these kids are runaways from local orphanages or abusive home situations. They sleep in the sewers and under high rise apartments to keep warm and somewhat safe from those who would continue to abuse them by raping, beating, or even murdering them. Rustam and his team keep the doors open for those who really want help.

Our next stop was to feed the homeless. There are never any questions asked and no one is turned away. They just go to where the need is and try their best to fill that need.

I watched as Rustam, Sveta and their team interacted with the homeless. I had the privilege of

getting to know one of the men on the right. Antone (the one on my right in camouflage) took a liking to me. He was very respectful and listened carefully to what was said. We had hoped to see him in church the next morning but for whatever reason he did not come.

Following the homeless we went to some families that are totally poverty stricken. The lady and her children on the left live in a house that is partially burned down. It is cold but it does have a roof. They have no money and are very dependant on the help they receive. There is a man that lives with them and he is usually drunk and out of his mind. It seems like a hopeless situation for this woman. Her children hate the abuse. Clothing is furnished by Rustam and his organization as well.

We went to another family that live in two rooms with a shared kitchen and shared toilet facilities by the other tenants in the apartment complex. The parents were gone and had been for days and the kids were anxiously waiting for their food. The only stipulations for receiving food is they don't smoke or do drugs while the team is there.

The next morning I went to Rustam and Sveta's church. They had asked me to preach and I felt so honored. In the church were drug addicts, prostitutes, and other sinners who were welcomed with great love. Over 100 people who were hungry for God's word. This church is in the beginning stages of growth but I know that God will bless them as they continue to reach out to those no one wants.

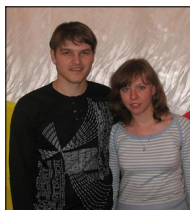

It reminded me of our own organization, NHOM, and how we are also very dependent on God to supply the needs through folks like yourselves and others. What You Don't See

A number of years ago God placed a conviction on my heart. I had showed in our newsletters the ugliness of some of the things we see in some of the areas we work. I would show them for impact to play on peoples feelings. When this conviction came the Lord spoke to me and told me to show the people what God has done. Since that time to this I do not intentionally show anything other than the joy of what God is doing amid our widows and orphans.

Some of you can read between the lines. You can see beyond the pictures. When I am at the churches I do tell some different stories than what I can publish. You must remember these are orphans and they need love no matter what they look like in the pictures.

The kids you see on the opposite page are fatherless. Many have received Christ as their personal savior and the smile you see is a direct result of that change in their lives. Others are smiling because they realize they are not forgotten but that somebody loves them.

You don't see their heartache. You don't see the abuse they have gone through. You don't see the tears at night as they long for their parents or someone to love them. You don't see so much of the hurt that eats at them. You don't see the fear of an unknown future that is set before them. You don't see the hunger for someone to hold and comfort them. You don't see the loneliness that gnaws at them 24 hours a day and all of that is OK.

Just remember that God wants us to visit the fatherless and widow. He wants to use all of us to be His hands, feet or spokesperson and carry, with demonstration, His love to those who are unloved. Someone once said, "You may be the only Jesus that people see!" How do they see Jesus in your life? Do they see a mean, angry, prejudiced Jesus or do they see a loving, kind and compassionate Jesus who loves everyone? We at NHOM hope they see the Jesus who loves them through us.

I had a dream not to long ago and this is what I dreamed. I was sitting in a theater and hundreds of orphans were parading before me. Each one had a huge smile on their face. When the last one passed by with her huge smile I asked her name? The orphan said, "My name is Nobody." I thought the little girl was joking because of the big smile so I asked her name again and the child replied, "My name is Nobody." Again I thought she was joking. So a third time I asked the girl in a more serious tone, "What is your name?" Then in a more forceful reply, still with a big smile on her face, the girl said, "MY NAME IS NOBODY!" Immediately I woke up.

You see that is what the orphans and widows we work with feel about themselves because that is how they are treated in the areas we work in. We at NHOM tell them that they are somebody in the eyes of God and in our eyes. Our teams minister to them and serve them as if they are the greatest somebody's in the world and you help make that possible.

A friend of ours sent an e-mail after she read Romans 9 in the "Message" this quote; "I'll call nobodies and make them somebodies; I'll call the unloved and make them beloved. In the place where they yelled out, "Your nobody! They're calling you "God's living children."

While Evelyn was having this dream in America another woman was having an identical dream in the Ekaterinberg church with one exception. The children in her dream were the aborted babies of our world.

God did not create nobodies, He created us to be somebody. In Ephesians 2:10 NLT it says: "For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so that we can do the good things he planned for us long ago."

We are God's masterpiece! When is the last time you thought of yourself as a masterpiece? That is how God sees us, even in the womb.

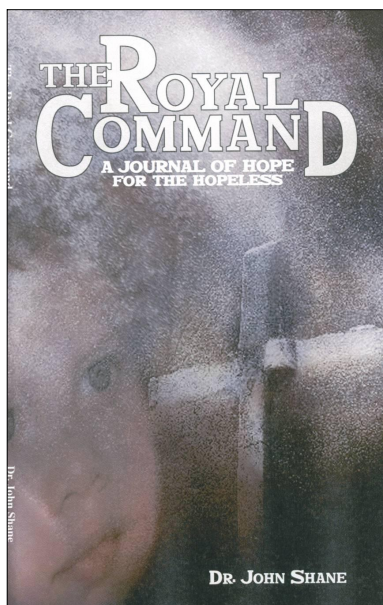

Costs vary by trip. As of this Writing our two week trip to Russia is around \$1,400.00 plus airline tickets & VISA fees. Sri Lanka is \$100.00 per day plus tickets.

All prices based on Seattle, WA departure and return. Costs may vary per trip but do include all visas, plane, rail and ground transportation, housing and an average of two meals per day except in Moscow, Odessa or Colombo. Souvenirs, offerings and gifts to the churches and individuals are at your own expense. We do limit our trips to the first 15 people. Sri Lanka is limited to the first 3 people.

Deadline for any of our trips we must receive your first deposit (\$500.00) four months prior to leaving.

Our trips are usually 14 to 15 days in length. A complete refund less \$100.00 handling fee of the unused portion of your deposit will be returned should circumstances keep you from going on the trip. For more information call or write the above address or phone number. To save time and expense for you, I would encourage you to **begin now to get your Passport**. We can not process you until I have your passport in hand.
