Love God and Love Your Neighbor as We Love Ourselves

As many of you who have heard me preach you realize that God has allowed me to share about the two commandments "Love God and love your neighbor as yourself." It is very easy for me to love the orphans, elderly and widows as they are starved for someone to love them. I, like you, have many questions I would like to ask the Lord and I really don't have a lot of answers as to why things are the way they are.

We visited a handicapped orphanage in the Perm Region. There were 220 kids here, most with mental disorders ranging from fairly minor to serious problems. We had a wonderful time sharing and hugging the kids. Almost all raised their hands for salvation. I recognized some of these kids from the last time I visited about two years ago.

Our tendency is to avoid the hurting because we don't know what to do or say. I recently talked to my friends Ron and Ruth Pomerantz who have a son who was born with Downs Syndrome. This same son, Zack, recently went through extensive chemotherapy for leukemia and is now in remission after months of hospitalization. Through all of this they have set a standard for me and my family as they realize that all they have gone through is God's will in their lives. They don't always understand Gods ways and they are great people of faith. Ruth told me the one thing she longed for during her many hours and days at the side of her son, was that of loving fellowship from her Christian friends. Just someone to give her a call on the phone, an e-mail message or a visit, in other words loving your neighbor as you love yourself.


I look at all these kids and the many handicapped orphanages we visit and their handicaps and see how dependent they are for help and wonder why God allowed this to happen and then it came to me. These kids are the way they are for many reasons two of which are:

- 1. God wants to teach us how to love our neighbors and these deserted fatherless children are just another means for us to demonstrate our love by tending to their needs. The elderly, sick, blind, crippled, hurting people of the world are simply opportunities for us to go and love God and our neighbors. We can not say we love God and not love our neighbors. We can not love our neighbors by avoiding them. Love is an action word and requires action by us to those with great need.
- 2. It also allows us to demonstrate our love of God when he says, "When you have done it to the least of these you have done it unto me."

If we will just take time to look around I believe we could see those with great needs and God wants us to demonstrate His love through us to them. The loneliness and isolation that the hurting experience because we don't take the opportunities God gives us to demonstrate His love is sometimes deplorable.

I remember holding the hand and praying for a dying orphan at an orphanage as he looked at me in the waning moments of his life and said to me, Thank You. No one should be without the opportunity to be loved and that is why God created you and me, to love God and to love our neighbors.

Many of the children and adults we work with have seen some horrible things in their lives. Beaten, abused, forsaken, deserted and left to die or fend for themselves these are the ones who God wants us to reach with His love. These are the rejects, the down and outers, alcoholics, prostitutes, murderers, sinners these are the ones that need the Master Physician and you and I are the ones who must introduce these hurting folks to Jesus.



your dad was to you. Unfortunately the kids we work with for the most part do not have good memories or no memories of a loving father.

I have been to many orphanages and so many times I have had these kids hug me and not let go. Many have asked if I would be their father as they have wept in my arms? They are just boys and girls looking for something they have never had and are willing to accept and try to please anyone who will offer them love.

That is why it is so important for us to reach them with God's love before Satan reaches them with a false love. With your help we can do so much more.

Sri Lanka 2008 January / February

Costs vary by trip. As of this Writing our two week trip to Russia is around \$1,400.00 plus airline tickets & VISA fees. Sri Lanka is \$100.00 per day plus tickets.

All prices based on Seattle, WA departure and return. Costs may vary per trip but do include all visas, plane, rail and ground transportation, housing and an average of two meals per day except in Moscow, Odessa or Colombo. Souvenirs, offerings and gifts to the churches and individuals are at your own expense. We do limit our trips to the first 15 people. Sri Lanka is limited to the first 3 people.

Deadline for any of our trips we must receive your first deposit (\$500.00) four months prior to leaving.

Our trips are usually 14 to 15 days in length. A complete refund less \$100.00 handling fee of the unused portion of your deposit will be returned should circumstances keep you from going on the trip. To save time and expense for you, I would encourage you to begin now to get your **Passport.** We can not process you until I have your passport in hand.
