**The Hands of Friendship**

At the orphanages in Ekaterinberg we are doing something a little different. Our NHOM director, Igor, is very diligent in teaching the orphan children about God's love and teaching them that they need to love their neighbors as they love themselves as well. Igor and Olga have developed a new theme this year at the orphanages. The children's palms are painted and they place their palm on a sheet of paper. Once a palm print is placed on the paper then a picture of all who took part is made. When the photograph is complete, it is sent to special places and countries thanking those who take part for praying for them.

Our teams develop a number of different programs each year for the kids they minister to. We use puppets, costumes, clowns, music, videos, and whatever else we can find to help these kids through some of the most difficult times of their lives.



**Clowning Around in Perm**

Our team of Natasha and Olga in the Perm region of Russia have developed quite a ministry using their own designs of clowns. They show their programs in orphanages, elderly homes, children's hospitals, children's prisons and drug rehabilitation centers.

Olga tells us they went to an elderly home they had not been to before. She said there were about 50 elderly present. They showed them a program with the clowns, did skits and preached the Gospel. She said they were so open to receiving Christ. When they were finished the elderly were crying and kissing and hugging all the team members. She said they see the thirst in peoples hearts for God everywhere they go. They are in need of a good quality printer and a decent laptop so they can do more and better programs. Maybe you can help with finances for these items?



## Ukraine

Our NHOM director in Odessa, Ukraine, Viktoria, and her team often visit the elderly. It is at these times we often think about our futures. These have given their lives for their country and in return they are confined to some of the spiritually darkest places on earth. We try our best not to judge these situations and must try to love these who will soon slip off into eternity.

We go and clean them, read to them, pray with them, offer them eternal hope through the Word of God. Many confess their sins and receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.



Our teams travel about a thousand miles each week seeking out the orphans, widows and elderly in their regions so they can minister to them.

I was in one elderly home where 20 old people lived. There was no running water, only outhouses for toilets and only one caretaker and she was drunk. Over half of the elderly were in such poor physical condition they could not get out of bed. We went in and ministered to them. The bedding and clothing was so soiled it made me gag. There was no place to wash anything except at the local well. They sleep with what clothing they own because they are afraid they may not have anything when they wake up. They have little or no medications for pain and family or friends have simply deserted them.



There is no Medicare or medicade to help them. They have been left to die. They are no longer any use to society or family. Their government supplies little or no help.

We washed them, gave them some simple food items and told them about Jesus. They hung on to our every word. Many had never had the opportunity to hear about a Savior of their souls. Many had not had a hug or been tended to in some time. Many are given Bibles by our teams and we are blessed as we see what God does in their lives as the Word becomes life to them. When we left they hugged us, kissed us and wept openly at the joy our

team had brought to them. Pictured above is one of our volunteers giving this dear woman a New Testament and telling her about the love of God.

### Opening Of Ethiopia

There is much preliminary work to be done when we go begin a new work in isolated parts of the world. When possible we solicit the help of Pastor's and churches in the area. We try to make contacts in the local community and want to see the response and hear the concerns they may express. We want them to know we are not there to line their pockets with goods or money from America. We want to make our mission as clear as possible to everyone concerned. In our work in Ethiopia we were so blessed to have some Ethiopian-American folks who had a burden for this area of the world. Their ideas and

trust in God fit the agenda of NHOM.

In July, 2009 our first lead team went in and set the ground

work for the future work of NHOM. Led by Pastor Ambelie Negash of Kent, Washington our new work began. While on a month long trip to the north part of Ethiopia he was able to establish relations with friends and Pastor's and was able to open an orphanage with 10 girls and find a Godly woman director.



The pictures in the upper left and lower right are the children that have been introduced to our newest orphanage. They were given new clothes, a place was rented to house them in and essentials are being provided. Most importantly they are being cared for by a loving director and under the Pastoral care of one of the local Pastors. They are learning about Christ while at the same time



being accepted by their local community.

The upper right picture is of a local church and their Sunday School and the picture on the lower left is of several brothers attending a local Bible school. We are thrilled about the opportunity God has placed before us and the many challenges yet to be faced and met. Now how can you help?
