Ever since I have been going on Missions trips I have journaled the events of the day. This a copy of a page from my journal on my trip to Ethiopia in August and September 2013.

Saturday August 31, 2013

I got up and began to take a shower, got all soaped up and the water shut off. I had to finish my shower out of the sink where a drib-

ble of water ran. You just have to be prepared for anything here.

We had a great time at the prayer meeting today. It began at 9 and was still going at 1. I Preached and God moved mightily in our midst with healings, salvations, repentance and the presence of His love. What a great privilege God has granted me to take part in this special time.

> On the way to church this morning Brother Atika and I walked about half way before hailing a Baja (taxi) for the rest of the trip. I noticed along the way that there were many sick, blind and lame people lying on the sidewalks. Many of these poor souls were simply destitute with no one to help them. There was one man that stood out in my mind. He was lying nude (upper right photo) on the sidewalk and had sores all over his body. Many of the open sores were infested with flies. He was so thin and weak he could not even beg nor swat at the flies. I noticed that no one paid him any attention. I decided that after the service I would at least go back and pray for him and this I did.

> I don't understand a lot of things. I don't know when the decision is in peoples lives they decide the poor should be left alone or we shouldn't help the truly needy. I don't know when we become so callous that we no longer care.

I see it so often in all the countries I work including America. I see it in Russia and Ukraine as they turn their backs on the orphans, handicapped and elderly. I see it in Sri

Lanka as widows are treated as if they have the plague and are shunned by society. In America where we have allowed a spirit of fear to dominate our lives and attitudes. We are so afraid of the absolutes of God. We are afraid to call sin sin. We are afraid to take a stand for or against anything. We are afraid to call people on things they say that is simply wrong. We fear what people might think about us when we stand for something. We are fearful to trust God. I stand for Jesus Christ as a Christian and I am not afraid to say so. I am not perfect, far from it, but Christ is perfection personi-


fied and He tells us to be like Him.

We are all sinners but we don't have to continue in sin nor do we have to live like the sinful world we live in. When God says come out from among them He is telling us to be different from the world of sinners. We are to live our lives to please the Lord. Our lives should be a reflection of Jesus Christ.
